2223/26 Reports from District / County Councillors

Councillor Foster gave a brief update on arrangements for the new North Yorkshire Council.

Apologies had been received from Councillor Metcalfe.

2223/27 Highways Matters

a) To receive an update on footpaths in the parish and consider any action required

The Council considered footpaths in the parish in light of discussions with residents at the Annual Parish Meeting. It was noted that nettles make some footpaths almost impassable. The Council **resolved** to draft a specification and request quotes from contractors to strim three paths to a width of 1.5m. The three footpaths are the lane to the sheepdip, the lane to the car park and from Firth Demesne to Lane Ends Barn. Councillor Vetch will draft a specification and circulate to councillors. **Resolved** to set a budget of up to £500 for the year for this work, to come from the Council's general reserves.

Councillor Ramsden advised of issues on the area between Hartrigg House and The Croft. Japanese Knotweed is growing and will need to be properly

dealt with. Councillor Ramsden will draft a proposal for consideration at the meeting in July.

b) To consider any highways issues in the parish and any action required

The Council noted that there will be a road closure in Starbotton between 10pm and 2 am from the 27th June until the 1st July. The Council have been advised that residents will be allowed to pass through but that at times they may have to wait up to ten minutes.

The Council agreed that Seal Bank be included on the agenda for the meeting in July.

c) To receive an update from the Road Safety Working Group

No update was available. This item was deferred until the next meeting.
