### **BUCKDEN TO FLEET MOSS – ROAD CLOSURE FOR CARRIAGEWAY PATCHING**

This letter is to inform you that the North Yorkshire County Council will be undertaking highway maintenance at the above location, between Hubberholme and Fleet Moss.

The works will involve a road closure and are currently programmed to commence on Tuesday 3 May, last for approx. 3 weeks and will be split into two sections:

The first section is from North of Oughtershaw village to Fleet Moss (i.e. the section that is currently closed for the drainage works) which is to commence on 3 May with a diversion via Hawes and Aysgarth.

The second section from Oughtershaw to Hubberholme will be started when the first section is complete, which is likely to be on 9 May, the diversion being the same via Hawes and Aysgarth.

Please also note that there may be times during the 3 week closure that other works will be underway on the A684 between Hawes and Bainbridge, where another diversion will be in place along the Askrigg to Sedbusk road. This diversion should be followed as part of the main diversion for the carriageway patching works.

The work is part of an extensive programme and as a consequence it is possible that some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise.

The closure for the works will be carried out between the hours of 07:30 and 17:00. This may inevitably restrict vehicular access to properties directly affected but our contractors will try to assist you where possible during the working day through the use of on-site personnel tasked with managing access. If you require access to your property, then please approach the on-site personnel for assistance. Please be advised there will be extended periods when access will just not be possible due to the nature of the works and physical constraints of the site. Pedestrian access will be permitted but only at times when it is safe to do so. We request your assistance in the following ways:-

- If possible, make arrangements to store your vehicle at an alternative location;
- Please cooperate and comply with any instructions issued by the traffic management operatives and take extra care whilst within the works area.

A plan showing the extent of the works is shown on the back of this letter, for your information.

I would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any disruption that these works may cause and would again request your cooperation to help ensure an efficiently and safely executed project.
