Tearooms set to reopen on April Fool's day...



There's been a hint of spring in the air in Buckden over the past few days and one of our blackbirds has already decided to throw caution to the breeze and lay her eggs in our ivy.

We are delighted to announce that the tearooms will be **open again from 12.30pm on Saturday 1 April**. It may be April Fool's Day but we're not joking... And, over the winter, we've been scouring Yorkshire to come up with an improved choice of delicious local produce for you to try.

For the first time, we'll be serving vegetable soup at lunchtime. Made by the Yorkshire Provender company at Leeming Bar near Northallerton, it's fantastically tasty and filling and will be served with an Aga-warmed roll. Meanwhile, pheasant and juniper pies will be back on the menu, accompanied by sloe gin relish. The pheasant is from Nidderdale and the relish from Elvington near York.

There'll also be a wider choice of sandwiches to try – including Ribblesdale Goat's Cheese and spring onion – and we're excited to say we have bought a sandwich toaster and will be offering tempting hot paninis with pesto, chorizo, tomato and mozzarella. That might sound quite Mediterranean but we think we can justify it because the chorizo is made by the Three Little Pigs company on the Yorkshire Wolds (see picture)! And for dessert, you'll be able to opt for the indulgent West Winds Gateau of the Day, served with fresh Dales cream.

Naturally all the usual favourites – including gammon and eggs, omelettes and Yorkshire puddings – are staying on the menu, so you'll be sure to find something to your taste.
