

BUCKDEN WALKERS – SUNDAY 18TH AUGUST

MOSSDALE & COTTERDALE

Walk 6 in the **8 Walks of 8 Miles in 8 Dales** series.

Meet at the Buck Inn at 9.55am to leave in shared cars at 10am or meet at Appersett to start walking at 10.30am. Bring a packed lunch. Dogs to be on leads for some of the walk.

This is a scenic & varied 8 mile walk taking in two of the lesser known Dales and incorporating a visit to the beautiful Cotter Force, as painted by Turner.



The route follows the River Ure to Mossdale Head, passing alongside the old railway line, before continuing over a slight rise to Thwaite Bridge. There is a short, steep climb to our proposed lunch stop, before the route descends to the beautiful valley of Cotterdale.



A final, short climb through woods takes us to a track, with extensive views over Wensleydale, which descends gradually back to Appersett.

Finish with a visit to the Green Dragon at Hardraw for refreshments.
