Recipe for Mars Bar Krispie Traybake:

Ingredients:

- 100g softened butter
- 4 Mars bars (roughly chopped)
- 1 1/2 tbsp golden syrup
- 150g Rice Krispies
- 350g milk chocolate

Method:

- 1) Melt the 4 Mars bars, golden syrup and butter in a large bowl.
- 2) Add the Rice Krispies and mix till all combined.
- 3) Pour Krispie mix into a lined baking tray and press down firmly.
- 4) Melt the chocolate in a separate bowl.
- 5) Pour the melted chocolate on top of the Krispie mixture, making sure you spread it out and cover all of the top.
- 6) Leave the Krispie to set in the fridge for several hours.
- 7) Carefully use a sharp knife to cut into slices.
