And it's goodbye from us...

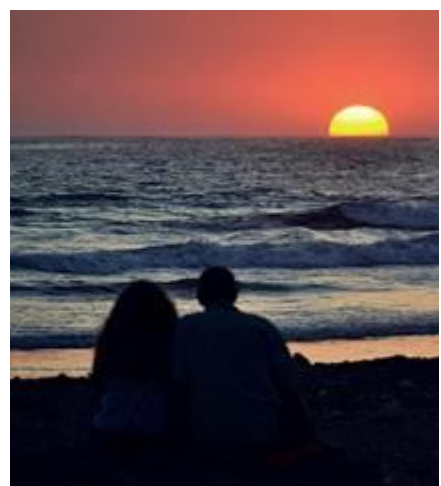
