

If making your own **Christmas cake** is as much a chore as scouring your local Forestry Commission property looking for a Christmas tree the right size, then simply don't make one. Instead, order your Christmas Cake from Lynn's Teatime Cakes. Made at West Winds (left), our Christmas cakes are baked to a very rich, brandy-laden recipe with plenty of fruit and topped with marzipan and icing. They are decorated with edible holly berries and leaves, hand-made from sugar-paste, and presented with a ribbon surround on a cake board in a smart white cake box.

Take a Winter Break at West Winds...



Remember, this year we are offering **bed and breakfast** throughout the cooler months, so you can come to stay during November, December, January or February. And we've turned the tearoom into a homely sitting room and breakfast room for guests. And if you opt for one of our **Winter Breaks**, we'll provide you with an evening meal that you can enjoy in front of the log fire.

A Winter Break is available for two people for at least two nights in either a double room or two single rooms and includes tea and cake on arrival, two-course evening meal with soft drinks and tea or coffee, plus a wide choice of cooked and continental breakfasts. You are welcome to bring your own wine for the evening – we can supply a cork screw and glasses and even finish off your bottle for you afterwards!

A two-night stay for two people, including dinner, bed and breakfast, costs £170 (£42.50 per person per night). You can stay an extra night for just £29 more. That's three nights with dinner, bed and breakfast for a total of just £199 (just over £33 per person per night). This offer is available until Sunday 1 March 2015.

- Wednesday 31 December: New Year's Eve takes you into next year with plenty of cheer in the local inns


