Justice & Peace Walk: 7th December 2014: Skipton - Threshfield

Note:

1. All walkers should be prepared to walk at a minimum rate of 2 miles per hour.
2. Options D and E are only intended for people wanting to only walk the first half of the route and will need to have someone trustworthy in navigating from a map which is available from John Byfield (see 7. below)
3. All times are **latest** departure times to arrive on time and leaving earlier than these would be likely on the day.
4. Anyone joining the walk would need to bring their own refreshments, especially lunch
Options A + B: 30 minute lunch at Rylstone
Option C: best to have lunch before setting off or on bus.
Options D + E: 30 minute lunch on Sharphaw only
Option A includes 2 x 15 minute breaks on Sharphaw and at Linton
Option B also includes a 15 minute break at Linton
5. The walk is planned with attending the Carol Service at St Margaret Clitherow's in Threshfield (at 3:00pm) in mind. For other options of catching buses see <http://getdown.org.uk/bus/bus/872.shtml> or arrange your own transport to/from the walk.
6. Mass opportunities are:
Option A: 6:00pm (Vigil mass) on Saturday evening or 6:00pm mass on Sunday evening both at St Stephen's
Options B - E: 6:00pm (Vigil mass) on Saturday at St Stephens, 8:30 at Broughton Hall, 9:30 at St Stephen's or 6:00pm on Sunday evening at St Stephen's
Anyone wishing to join after 11:00 am mass at St Margaret Clitherow's, Threshfield may be able to catch the bus leaving from opposite Upper Wharfedale School at about 11:57 and join the main walk at Cracoe. The bus arrives at Cracoe at 12:03 and you should have your lunch by 12:45 when the main walk should arrive at Fell Lane.
7. Anyone wishing to drive to join the walk en route can get further details from John Byfield on 01756 794007 or e-mail him on john.byfield@tesco.net. Please note that, apart from Cracoe and Rylstone, you need to consider how you will get back to your car after the Carol Service.
8. In the case of bad weather, either forecast or actual, the route may be altered for safety reasons. As such it will be very important that John has contact details for each person hoping to join the walk to advise them. Suitable clothing for all weather types and footwear for walking on fells and muddy or boggy ground is expected of all walkers in any case.
